

Wigan Handyman - £20 per hour explained

£20 per hour

That's it, I will charge you £20 for the first hour and I doesn't matter if you have 1 little job for me to do in that hour or 1 slightly bigger job.

EXAMPLES:

- If I arrive at 9am, you start paying me at 9am, not from when I left home because *I do not charge you for my travelling time or costs*. If I am finish at 9.15am it still costs you just £20 because that is the fixed fee for the first hour no matter how long I am there.
- If I arrive at 9am and I am finished any time between at 10.01am and 11am it costs you just £40, because I have gone over the hour.
- Some customers contact me and book me for "the day". If you do that it is your responsibility to task me with enough work for "the day" as I will block book "the day" to you and nobody else. The charge for "the day" is £160 for 8hrs.
- NOTE: Above apply 0900-1700 Mon to Friday. Weekends and Bank Holidays are all at Double Time. i.e £40 for first hour & £40 per hour thereafter.

Finally, if you do feel inclined to make me a cup of tea (milk and 2 sweeteners please ☺) then I will drink it whilst I am working so you will still be charged for my time.

Payment in cash please and a receipt will be supplied, I will be passing on 20% to the tax man ☺
